These scores were used as inputs for merit raise decisions and recommendations for this coming year. The results of the recommendations for merit raises were, as always, subject to the approval of the University of Houston System Board of Regents.

## Teaching (40%): Very good to Excellent= 4.60

Last year you taught 10 SWEN and SENG rubric sections of 3 different courses. Thank you for teaching overload. You received very good student evaluations. You advised students of both SWEN and SENG programs. You were nominated for the Minnie Stevens Piper Award.

Research (40%): Very good = 4.0 You submitted one conference paper. You presented one paper at the Innovations 2003 conference. You assisted Dr. Dickerson on RICIS research activities. You were responsible for the Rational software donation continuation of 50 licenses for the UCT open lab and the division's NT lab.

## Service (20%): Excellent = 5.0

You served on the Admissions Committee of both Systems Engineering and Software Engineering programs. You participated in student advising during the Graduate Open House and during the open registrations. You presented to NASA and Contractors the Masters programs in SWEN and SENG. You reviewed 5 papers for the IEEE American Control Conference. You coordinated and hosted Innovations 2003 at UHCL. You are a member of INCaSE and you coordinated and hosted several events of the Houston Chapter of INCaSE at UHCL. We appreciate your positive attitude and your willingness to help out whenever the needs arise.
