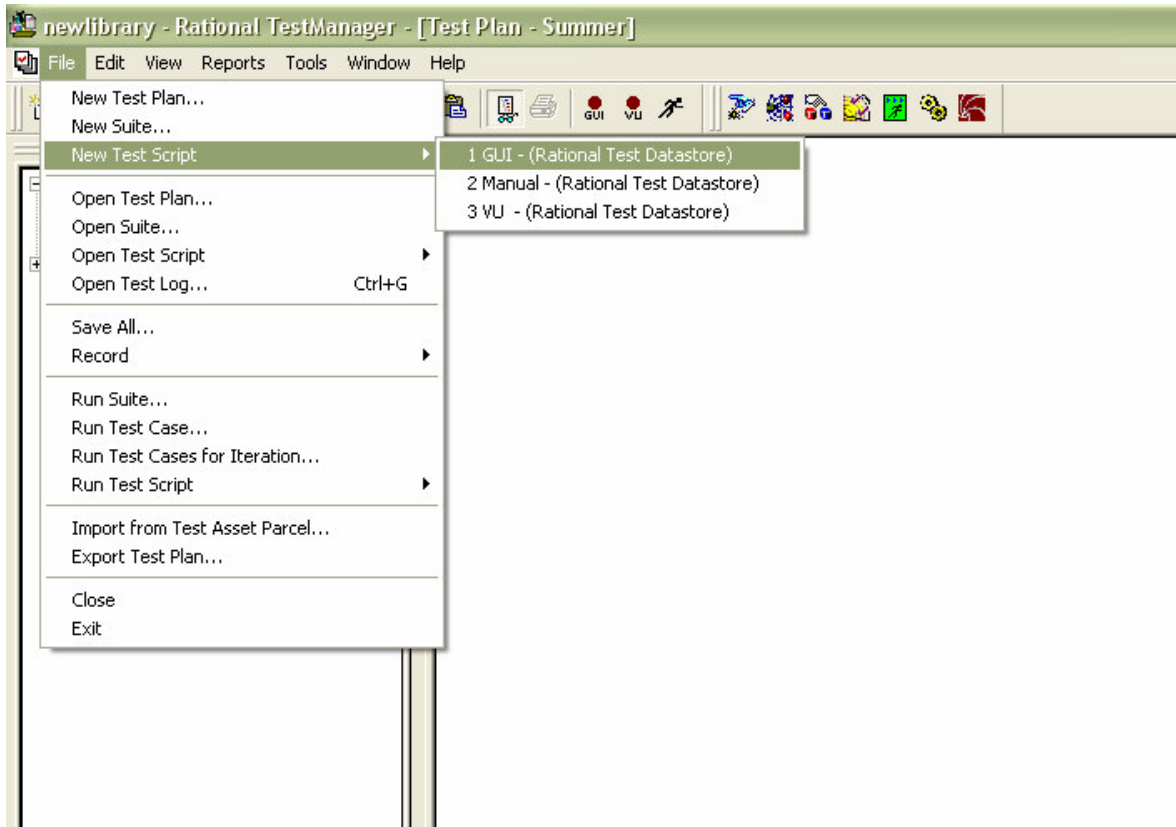



Rational Robot User Guide

Testing a Web Interface

1. From Test Manager Select File > New Test Script > GUI

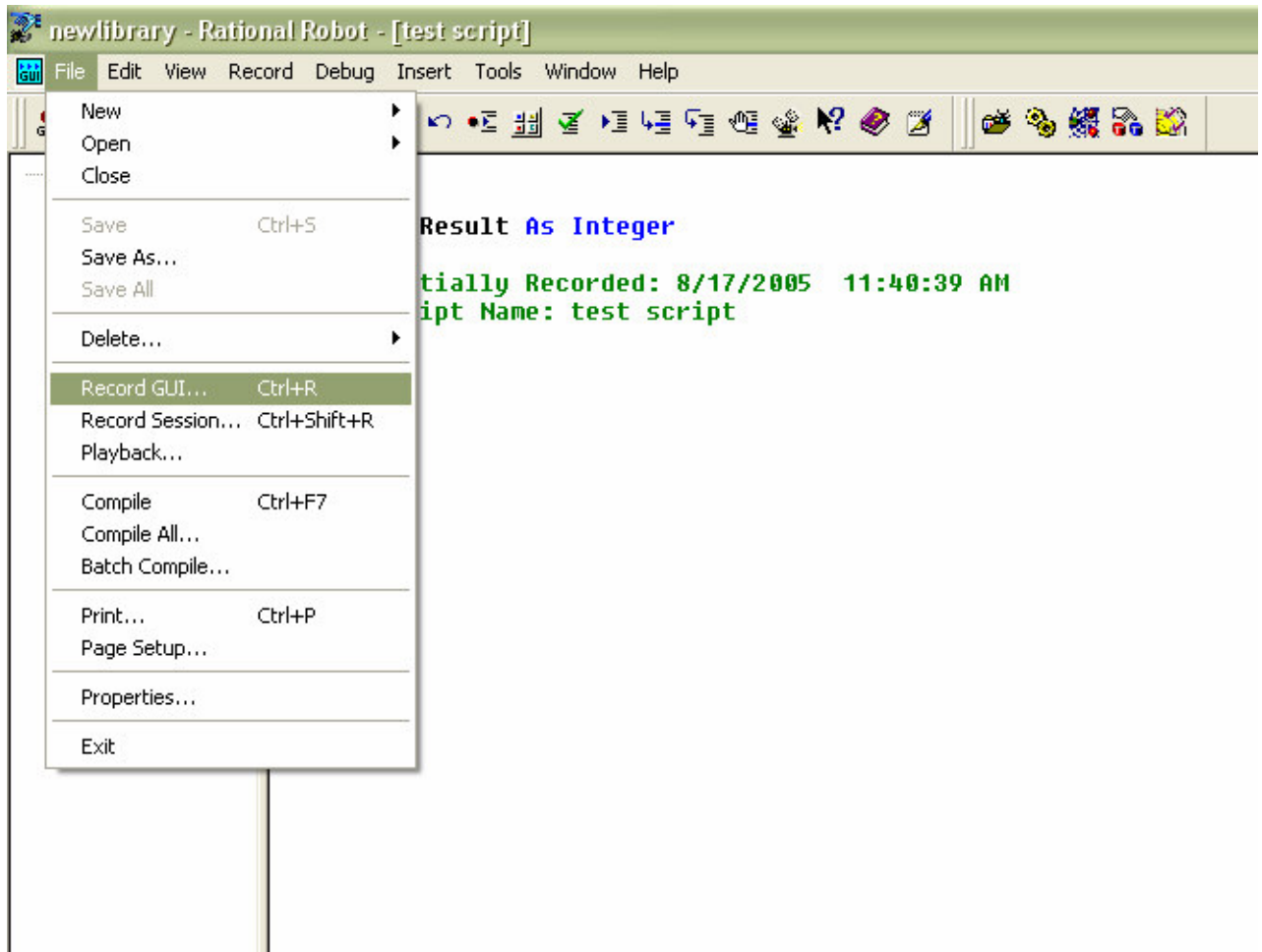


2. Enter a name and description for the test script and press ok

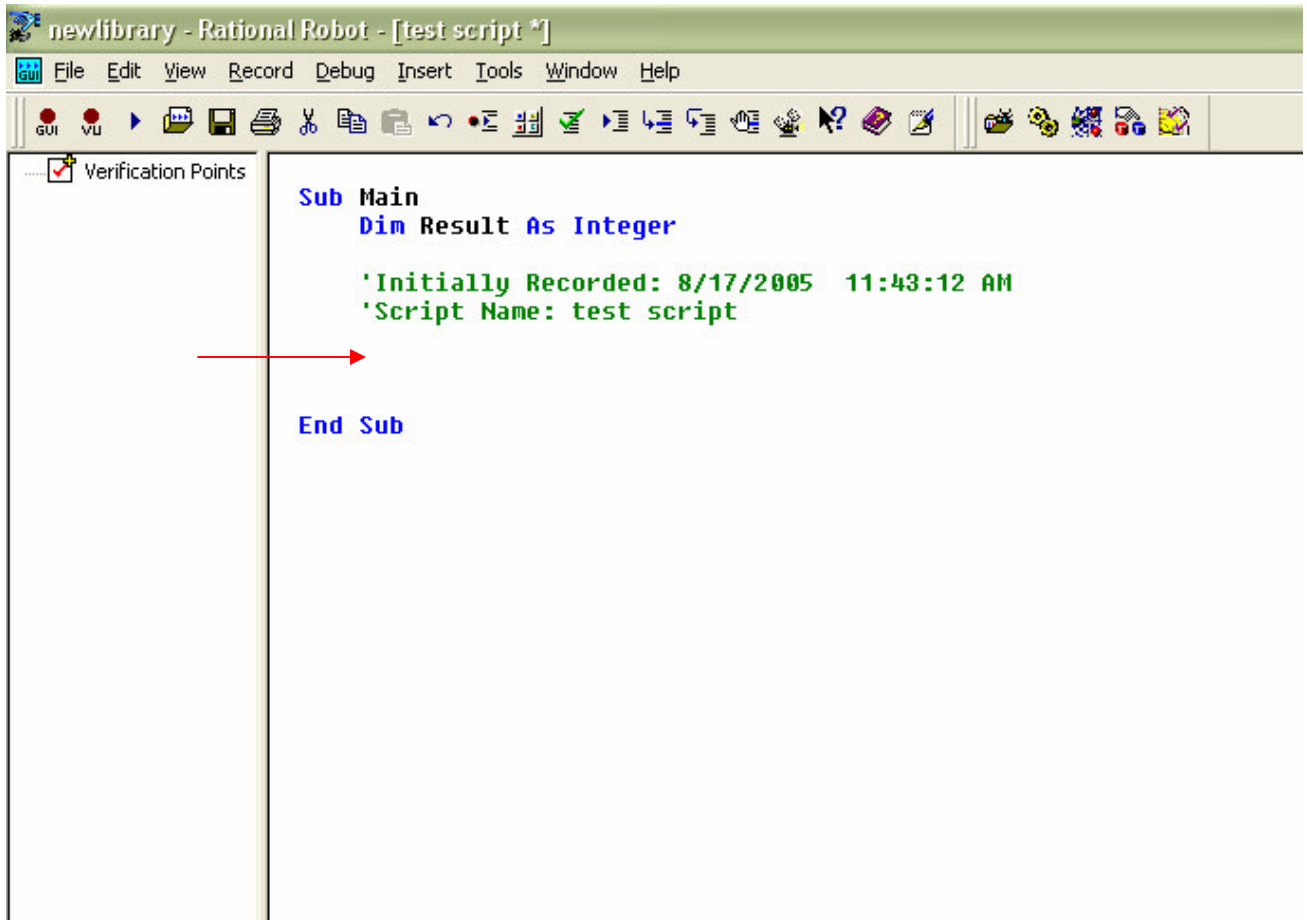

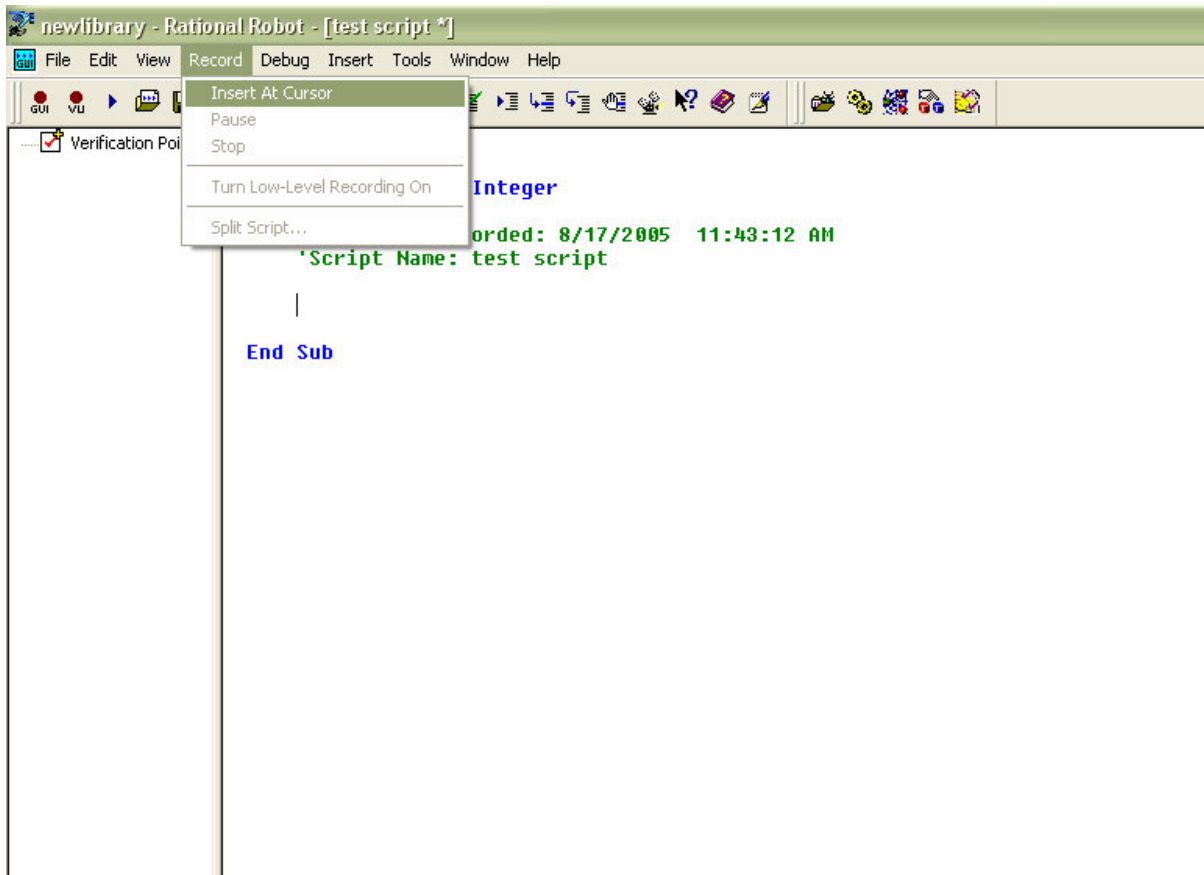
3. In Robot select File > Record Gui



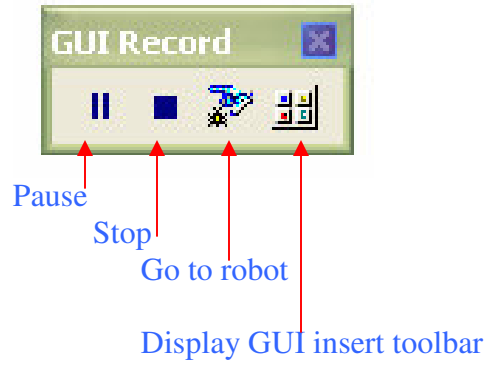
4. Place the cursor after where the script name is defined
