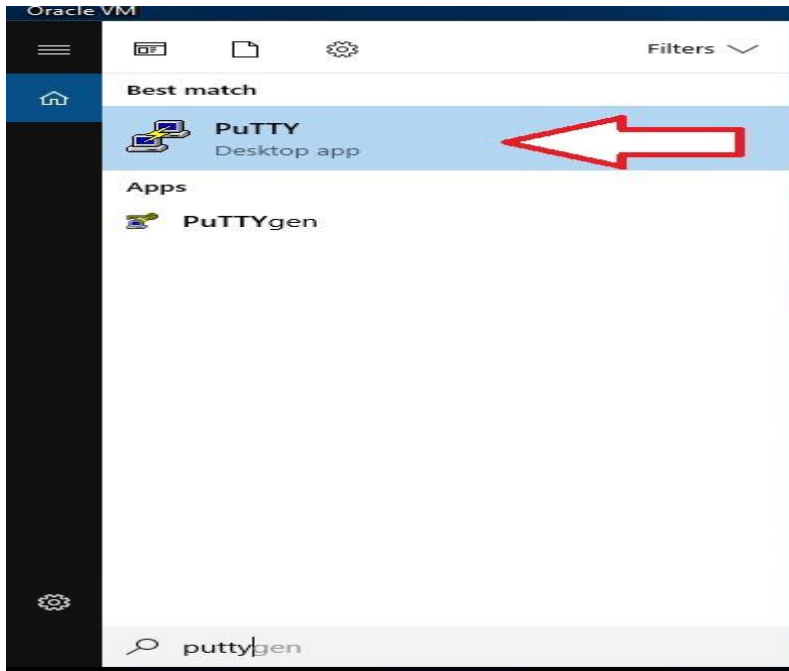


Installation of PUTTY SSH client

You can download Putty SSH client from following URL <http://ninite.com/putty/>

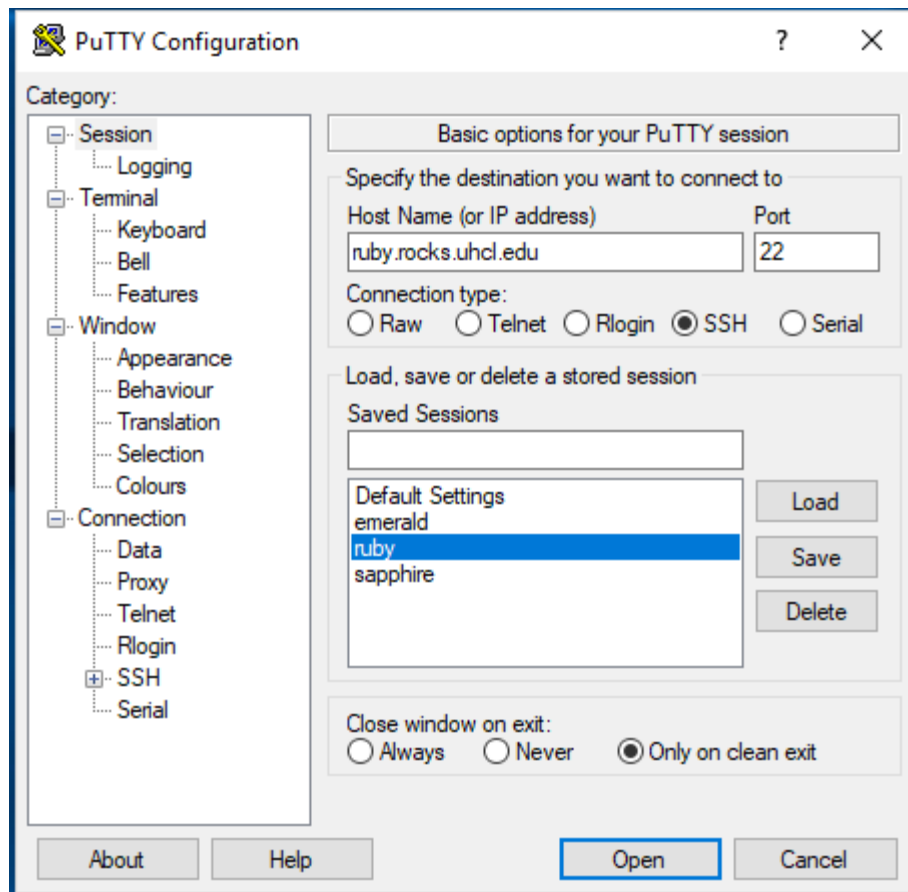
Clearing cache on Unix Account using Putty Step 1:

- Search Putty on Windows search option.
- Select Putty

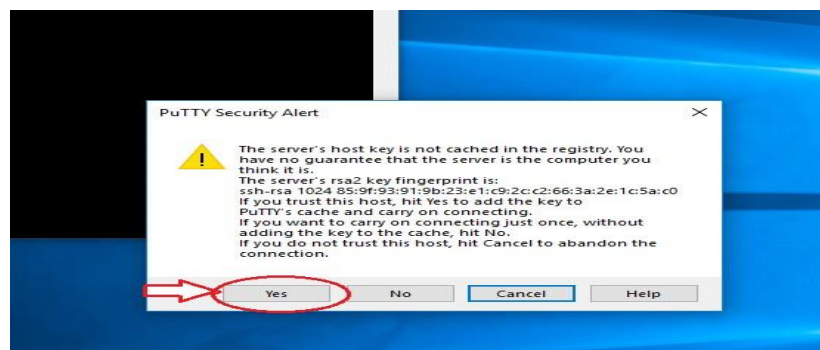


Step2:

- Upon selecting Putty, Putty Configuration Screen appears.
- Enter **ruby.rocks.uhcl.edu** in host name (or IP Address).
- Click on "Open".



- A Security Dialog Box appears if the user is logging in for the first time, click on 'Yes'.



Step3:

- Login using, your UNIX account Username and password.
